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The Scientific Committee

- Responsible of all scientific activities of practicing pharmacists in Lebanon
- Responsible of scientific improvement that will lead to a better quality of pharmacy practice
- Responsible of data generation related to the profession, to back up managerial and professional decisions





- Build the workforce capacity of pharmacists to meet the growing challenges related to optimizing the use of medicines
- ▶ Ensure the recognition of the pharmacist as the expert professional for medication governance, information and management.



Enable research and development of excellence in pharmacy practice through building **knowledge expertise** and **skills** of the workforce to achieve optimal health outcomes.





Objectives

The objectives are to create educational activities that will enable pharmacists to:

- Optimize patient centered care
- Improve quality and safety of medication use
- Increase operational efficiency of the medication process
- Promote leaders/experts in medication therapy management
- ▶ Ensure proper credentialing, development and training
- Explore the possibility to apply technology and automation
- Foster collaboration with healthcare team, and
- Promote pharmacy practice research

Medication Safety Subcommittee

- Responsible of Medication Safety culture implementation in Lebanon.
- Ongoing activities:
 - Assessment of the Medication Safety knowledge, attitude and practice among pharmacists and the general population
 - Implementation of the Medication Safety notification system
 - Data analysis and reporting to concerned authorities





Research Subcommittee

 - Health-related research strategy development (through bibliometric methods)
 - Antibiotics related situation assessment and sensitization campaign
 - Training development for pharmacists on Good Research Practice
 - Diverse research projects implementation through an electronic platform

Academic Board Subcommittee

- Objective: bridging the gap between academia and practice
- Activities:
 - Setting the minimal competencies necessary for general and specialized pharmacists at entry level (at the moment of graduation): pharmacy education standards and accreditation
 - Organizing the Colloquium, in collaboration with the Ministry of Education and the Lebanese University
 - Discussing the possibility for establishing residency training
 - Discussing the possibility for establishing Pharmacy board
 - Starting a collaborative interuniversity diploma in MTM
